Waiver and acknowledgment of risks involved

I understand that the ride involves cycling on public roads which are open to general traffic and I am aware of the hazards associated with this and also the inherent risks associated with cycling.

In my assessment I have sufficient riding competence and experience and have undertaken adequate training to participate in this event. I recognise that the bike used must be in sound mechanical condition and I will wear a correctly fitted Standards approved cycling helmet.

I agree to comply with Victorian road rules and to directions given by the Victorian Police, VicRoads and Bikevents Australia marshals in the interests of safety.

I hereby release, exempt and indemnify Bikevents Australia, the Oncology Children's Foundation, Mansfield Shire Council, Mt Buller & Mt Stirling Alpine Resort Management Board, sponsors and all other persons involved in the event from and against any claims, liability, costs and expenses whether in negligence or otherwise which may arise in connection with this event.

Where I have a known medical condition that may affect not only my safety but that of others whilst involved with this event I will inform Bikevents Australia in writing prior to the commencement of the ride.

Bikevents Australia reserves the right to alter the route and venues provided on this event without notice and reserves the right to refuse admission to any person, irrespective of successful registration.

Cancellations

Bikevents Australia are under no obligation to refund monies; other than to those who enter online via Register Now.

Accommodation enquiries can be made to Mansfield-Mt Buller The High Country Reservations and any accommodation cancellations are subject to their own booking conditions.

Age Limit Requirements

Persons under 18 years old MUST be accompanied by a responsible guardian. The 200km, 165km and 125km rides are not recommended for riders under 16 years of age.

Promotional kit

The first 600 entrants will receive a free SCODY High Country Cycle Challenge souvenir jersey. If you are one of the first 400 entrants, you will also receive a free pair of SHCCC knicks.

Kit will be available for collection between 6pm and 9pm on Friday 16 March at the Mansfield Visitor Information Centre.

Eligible entrants can also collect their kit at Registration in High Street, Mansfield between 7am and 8.30am on Saturday 17 March.

Eligible entrants of the Sunday rides can collect their kit at the Registration Tent in High Street, Mansfield between 7am and 8.30am on Sunday 18 March.

We'd prefer you to wear your souvenir kit during the SCODY High Country Cycle Challenge as proof of entry to the event.

King of the Mountain / Queen of the Mountain

All entrants to the 200km, 165km or 100km rides will be supplied with a transponder in an envelope which includes mounting instructions and the name of the rider it is issued to. The supplied transponder remains the property of Castech Sports Technology. The named rider is responsible for the safe return of the transponder to Castech. A \$30 fee may be charged to any rider who does not return a transponder.

Wrist Band

Each entrant will be supplied a colour-coded wrist band which must be worn during the event. This has emergency contact numbers printed on it. It signifies your entry to the event, gaining you access to snacks and drinks along the course and massages at the finish.

Common Sense

You must ride in a safe and responsible manner during the Cycle Challenge weekend and use common sense at all times. You should exercise caution on all public roads and operate defensively and courteously.

Special Requirements

We welcome people with disabilities on the Cycle Challenge and ask that other riders show the same consideration and support they would expect to receive from other riders. Bikevents Australia will use all reasonable efforts to cater for your particular disability where able.

Food during the ride

Bikevents Australia will provide snacks, fruit and drinks only during the Cycle Challenge. Any other food or dietary requirements are the responsibility of the entrant. All entrants must be wearing their supplied wrist band as proof of entry to gain access to snacks and drinks provided by Bikevents Australia.

Sag Wagon

A trailing support vehicle for riders is provided by Bikevents Australia. The Sag Wagon travels behind the last riders on the ride and usually arrives late to the finish.

Event & course variation

Bikevents Australia reserves the right to vary the venue, course or other services on the Cycle Challenge without notice. All or any part of the course may be closed at any time by Bikevents Australia for any reason. Course closure means that riders on the closed course will be given an opportunity in the Sag Wagon to be transported to an appropriate location from which they may safely reach the Stage Finish. Any rider who chooses to decline this opportunity will not be supported by Bikevents Australia and will have to make their own way to the Stage finish.

Private support vehicles

Private support vehicles are NOT PERMITTED on the Cycle Challenge. Bikevents Australia provides support along the course. Additional vehicles on the course increase the risk to all road users. Any private support vehicles identified on the Cycle Challenge will be brought to the attention of the Police.

Photography

Participants understand and agree that they may be photographed or filmed on the Cycle Challenge and that Bikevents Australia may use this footage for future promotional needs by coming on the Cycle Challenge and agreeing to these Conditions of Entry.

Entrants agree to the creation and use of such footage for future Bikevents Australia promotions and publicity.
